

Registration is now open for projects to participate in the Iberseries & Platino Industria Co-Production and Financing Forum

- The **call** is aimed at **filmmakers, directors, producers and cinematographers** from **Ibero-America** with **feature film projects** and **fictional series, docuseries and animations** in **advanced stages of development**.
- Project managers will have the opportunity to find **producing, creative, financial, and international sales partners** and **agents**, among the accredited professionals present during the event.
- The **Co-Production and Financing Forum**, an activity supported by **ICEX España Exportación e Inversiones** with **Audiovisual from Spain**, will take place on **October 4 and 5, 2023**, as part of the **third edition of Iberseries & Platino Industria**, the **largest Ibero-American audiovisual event**, promoted by **EGEDA** and **Fundación Secuoya**, with the collaboration of **FIPCA**.

Madrid, April 12, 2023. The **third edition of Iberseries & Platino Industria** opens **registration** to participate on **October 4 and 5, 2023** in the **Co-Production and Financing Forum**, aimed at filmmakers, directors, producers and cinematographers from Ibero-America with feature film projects and fiction series, docuseries and animations in advanced development stage.

A maximum of **10 fiction, docuseries and animation series projects** and a maximum of **10 fiction, documentary and animation feature film projects** will be selected, based on the reports prepared by international experts.

Those responsible for the projects will have the opportunity to find **producing, creative, financial, and international sales partners** and **agents**, among the accredited professionals present during the event. The organization will prepare a personalized schedule of **one-to-one appointments** with professionals interested in the selected projects.

The **Forum** will promote and facilitate connections with **co-production, co-financing, broadcasting and distribution partners**, with a special focus on projects that serve to strengthen ties between **Spain and Latin America**. The aim is to promote the **expansion of projects** with high levels of production, and to **strengthen co-production models** between relevant stakeholders in the **audiovisual sector** in both **Latin America and Europe**.

Projects must have a **budget and financing plan** of at least **40% of the production cost** already secured for **fiction series** and at least **30%** for **feature films**. See all [requirements](#).

Professionals interested in participating in the **Co-Production and Financing Forum** may submit their application before **Tuesday, May 16** at 14:00 (GMT+2) via the web link provided in the **private professional area**, to which they will have access once the **accreditation** process has been formalized.

Iberseries & Platino Industria, the **largest international event for audiovisual professionals in Spanish and Portuguese**, will hold its **third edition** from **October 3 to 6** at **Matadero Madrid**, Centro de Creación Contemporánea. Promoted by **EGEDA** and **Fundación Secuoya**, in collaboration with **FIPCA**, and with the support of the **Madrid City Council**, the **Community of Madrid** and **ICEX España Exportación e Inversiones**, it will once again bring together **platforms, television networks, producers, distributors and buyers**, as well as entities and organizations dedicated to **tourism, education and new technologies** in a unique meeting point.

Audiovisual From Spain, a brand dedicated to the international promotion of Spanish companies in the film and TV content sector is an initiative of **ICEX España Exportación e Inversiones**, with the collaboration of the Instituto del Cine y de las Artes Audiovisuales (ICAA) and a range of public and private organizations

PROFESSIONAL ACCREDITATIONS

The **accreditation** in **Iberseries & Platino Industria** will allow access to the exclusive program of professional activities, as well as to all the processes of **calls for projects**.

In addition, in its face-to-face or virtual mode (**early bird rates available until May 15**), the **accreditation** will provide access to the **virtual private space**, an area that will allow access to the **professional directory** of participants to establish contact with accredited attendees and arrange **meetings** on a voluntary basis, and also to view the main **conferences and content** on demand, from 24 hours after its celebration until October 13.

PITCH CALLS FOR PLATFORMS AND PRODUCTION COMPANIES

Iberseries & Platino Industria 2023 has also opened **Pitch Calls for Platforms and Production Companies**. Projects for fiction and **animation feature films, series, superseries, fiction and non-fiction miniseries** (docuseries, docu-reality, reality series) and **animation series**, according to the criteria established in each call.

The companies that will listen to the selected projects in the **pitch sessions** are **Amazon Studios / Prime Video, Ánima, Dopamine, Gato Grande**. An **MGM Company, Gaumont Television, Paramount, Sony Pictures International Productions, TELEMUNDO STREAMING STUDIOS**, a Division of **NBCUniversal** and **Warner Bros. Discovery**.

The **closing date** for the various pitch **calls** is **Wednesday, May 3**, at 14:00 (GMT +2), Madrid time.
