



Iberseries & Platino Industria Co-Production and Financing Forum Opens Project Applications

The call is open to **Ibero-American filmmakers**, **directors**, **producers and cinematographers** with **feature film** and **series projects** (**fiction**, **docuseries and animation**) in **advanced stages of development**.

The **Co-Production and Financing Forum** will foster and facilitate connections with potential co-production, co-financing, distribution and dissemination partners, with a particular focus on projects that bridge the gap between **Europe** and **Latin America**.

This forum is supported by ICEX Spain Export and Investment and will take place on October 1-2, 2024, within the framework of the fourth edition of Iberseries & Platino Industria.

Madrid, April 18, 2024. The fourth edition of Iberseries & Platino Industria is now accepting applications for projects to participate in the Co-Production and Financing Forum, which will take place on October 1-2, 2024. The forum is aimed at Ibero-American filmmakers, directors, producers and cinematographers with feature film, fiction series, docuseries, and animation series projects in advanced stages of development.

The Forum, supported by **ICEX Spain Export and Investment**, will foster and facilitate connections with potential co-production, co-financing, distribution and dissemination partners, with a particular focus on projects that bridge the gap between Europe and Latin America, through its database of accredited professionals.

The goal is to promote the development of **projects** with **high production value**, thereby strengthening co-production models between key players in the Latin America and European audiovisual sectors.

Project producers must submit a budget and financing plan with at least 30% of the production cost already secured.

Iberseries & Platino Industria will select a maximum of **10 fiction series**, **docuseries** and animation projects and a maximum of **10 fiction**, **documentary and animation** feature film projects to participate in the **Co-Production and Financing Forum**, based on reports prepared by various international experts.

Project managers will have the opportunity to connect with potential **co-producers**, **creative partners**, **financiers and international sales agents** among the accredited professionals attending the event. The Forum organizers will prepare a **personalized**















schedule of one-on-one meetings with professionals interested in the selected projects.

The **deadline** for submitting applications to the **Co-Production and Financing Forum** is **Thursday, May 23**, at **4:00 PM** (GMT +2), Madrid, Spain time.

Participants must have a valid **accreditation** for **Iberseries & Platino Industria** at the time of registration and be available to attend the Forum **in person** on the dates it is to be held.

Project registration can be completed via the <u>professional profile</u> on the **Iberseries & Platino Industria** website, once the professional accreditation process has been formalized.
