What are the sources of inspiration for IPs and what opportunities are they creating? Among others, we will hear from **Ramón Campos**, CEO of **Bambú Producciones** (Spain) and creator of the recent and successful series "El caso Asunta", as well as screenwriter **Diego San José**, creator of "Celeste" (Spain).

Significant participation of international financial funds

In these sessions, the current state of the industry, the development of new business models, strategies, and partnerships will be discussed. In view of the financial uncertainty worldwide, the different financing models will be studied in depth to determine the appropriate approach according to requirements. Venture capital funds and private equity investors will discuss what they are looking for, what they are asking for in return, and the importance of risk mitigation.

Other issues to be explored will be how to finance and structure projects within a constantly changing market, making it easier to identify the financial resources associated with the creation and distribution of content, as well as the role of production companies and studios in obtaining financing for film and television projects.

US DAY event

Iberseries & Platino Industria 2024 will dedicate a **day-long event** to **US Hispanics content**, with the notable participation of international professionals who work on Spanish content in the US.

As a result, **US Hispanic stories** will be part of the conference program. Executives will reflect on how to approach the creation of films and series, the needs of commissioners, how they understand this audience and their language, and how the industry can improve to bring authentic projects to market that will appeal to the US Hispanic demographic and achieve commercial success. Under the guidance of hit makers, you will discover



how to produce this type of content. **Leonardo Zimbrón**, SVP International Coproduction & SP Features de **3Pas Studios** (EUA) y **Luis Balaguer**, CEO & Co-founder de **Latin World Entertainment** (EUA) will participate in this panel.

Furthermore, the attractiveness of the **Ibero-American market for the USA** will be examined as it is a growing market with the potential to reduce costs and work with local talent. Discussions will focus on opportunities and methods for coproduction between the USA and Ibero-American territories beyond services, the impact of different business models, and creativity, with the participation of **Jacobo Aparicio**, International Director of **Anonymous Content** (EUA).

Remakes beyond adaptations is another topic that will be covered. What are the reasons for adapting content, purchasing a successful format to minimize costs, avoid risks, and serve as an incentive to reach other audiences? Experts in adaptations will discuss whether success is easy to repeat, the countries in which to find IPs, how to create a franchise from scratch, and how to preserve the authenticity of the original concept.
